- Jesus Calling Storybook Bible
- watercolors
- paper

LESSON TWO

- white hair conditioner
- baking soda

- white crayon
- watercolors

LESSON THREE

- Jesus Calling Storybook Bible
- modeling clay or salt dough ingredients
- candle



LESSON ONE

PREPARE

Gather materials for reading this week's scripture and bible story (We like to use the Jesus Storybook Bible for bible stories)

Familiarize yourself with the scripture and reading

Gather watercolors, water, paper and marker

READ

Read aloud page 264 from The Jesus Storybook Bible "The Friend of Little Children"

LESSON SCRIPTURE

"I am God's masterpiece" Ephesians 2:10

DISCUSS

Here are some examples of what to talk about with your child:

- Discuss what you read. Did Jesus turn the little children away? God loved the children. God made each child. Each child was special and loved by Jesus.
- Ask them what they love about themself. Give examples of what you love about your child.
- Tell them "God loved you so much He made only ONE of you, noone else is the same"

ACTIVITY

- 1. Gather materials for reading scripture and bible story.
- 2. Begin the lesson by discussing the bible story and scripture you read.

 Refer to the discussion questions for help.
- 3. Remind your child that God loves them EXACTLY the way they are.
- 4. After discussing, provide your child with watercolor paper and watercolors.
- 5. For younger children, you may need to draw the outline of your child's face and shoulders.
- 6. Allow your child to use their watercolors to paint themselves.
- 7. Use a pen or marker to write the scripture "I am God's masterpiece" on top.









LESSON TWO

PREPARE

Gather materials for reading scripture and bible story (We like to use the Jesus Storybook Bible for bible stories)

Familiarize yourself with the scripture and reading
Gather white conditioner and baking soda for "snow"
Gather paper, white crayon, watercolors for snowflakes

READ

Read aloud page 264 from The Jesus Storybook Bible "The Friend of Little Children"

LESSON SCRIPTURE

"I am God's masterpiece" Ephesians 2:10

DISCUSS

Here are some examples of what to talk about with your child:

- Remind them of the reading or re-read. Remind them of what you discussed in the previous lesson.
- Ask them what they feel makes them special and different from anyone else.
- Tell them "God loved you so much He made only ONE of you, no-one else is the same"

ACTIVITY

- 1. Gather materials for reading scripture and bible story.
- 2. Begin by reviewing the bible story and scripture you read. Refer to today's discussion questions for help.
- 3. Remind your child that they were made special by God and no-one else is exactly like them (just like a snowflake!)
- 4. After discussing, draw snowflakes on a white sheet of paper then allow your child to use their watercolors to color over the crayon and reveal the hidden snowflakes beneath the watercolor.
- 5. Hang the hidden snowflake painting in your home as a reminder they are beautiful and unique just like each snowflake that falls from the sky.
- 6. For an extra activity, you can use equal parts white hair conditioner and baking soda to create "snow" for your child to play with.









LESSON THREE

PREPARE

Gather materials for reading scripture and bible story
(We like to use the Jesus Storybook Bible for bible stories)

Familiarize yourself with the scripture and reading
Gather modeling clay or salt dough ingredients, and candle

READ

Read aloud page 264 from The Jesus Storybook Bible "The Friend of Little Children"

LESSON SCRIPTURE

"I am God's masterpiece" Ephesians 2:10

DISCUSS

Here are some examples of what to talk about with your child:

- Remind them of the reading or re-read. Remind them of what you discussed in the previous lesson.
- Ask them what they feel makes them special and different from anyone else.
- Tell them that the same God that put the stars in the sky created YOU and that is super special.

ACTIVITY

- 1. Gather materials for reading scripture and bible story.
- 2. Begin by reviewing the bible story and scripture you read. Refer to today's discussion questions for help.
- 3. Remind your child that the same God that put each star in sky created YOU. That is amazing and special!
- 4. After discussing, use the modeling clay to mold a candle holder. Use glitter or trinkets to decorate if your child would like.
- 5. Allow time for the modeling clay to dry and harden. Once complete, place the candle in the mold. Light the candle at times to remind your child of the lesson. As they see the light of the candle, use this as an opportunity to remind them of how the same powerful God that made the stars to light the sky made them as well!
